

Eden Township Board of Supervisors

Minutes of the October 14, 2019 Meeting

Call-to-Order: Supervisor David Rineer called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attendance: Supervisors David Rineer, Randy Kylar and Joseph Rineer; Mark Rudy, Gerry Parker and Szilvia Troutman. Also the following members of the public: Jesse Lapp, Amos Ebersol, Dennis Blevins, Tom Spring, Dayton Kreider and Lawrence Stoltzfus.

Public Participation:

Dennis Blevins (Quarryville Library) gave a presentation about the Quarryville Library's finances.

Supervisors Meeting Minutes: The minutes of the September 10, 2019 Supervisors meeting were reviewed. David Rineer motioned, Joseph Rineer seconded to approve the minutes; motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report for September 2019, in the amount of \$346,437.85 (attached), was approved on a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

Payment of Bills: The list of bills to be paid in October 2019, in the amount of \$63,680.58 (attached), was approved on a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

SEO Report: The SEO report listed activity of \$0.00 for the month of September 2019.

Tax Collector's Report: The Tax Collector's report listed activity of \$1,472.22 for the month of September 2019.

Zoning Officer's Report: The Zoning Officer's report listed activity in the amount of \$1,080.70 for the month of September 2019.

Road Master's Report: The Road Master's report of activity in September 2019 was reviewed.

Solanco Public Safety Committee: No report.

Emergency Management: No report.

Southern Lancaster County Inter-Municipal Council: No report.

Correspondence: Received correspondence was reviewed and disseminated.

Old Business:

2020 Budget Meeting Dates: The budget meetings will be held on 10/15/19, 11/4/19 and 12/9/19 at 7 pm.

New Business:

Signing of Stormwater Plan – Benuel Wayne Lapp (Springville Rd): On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors approved signing the stormwater plan for Benuel Wayne Lapp (Springville Rd). Motion passed unanimously. **(Resolution #2019-10-14-01)**

Return of SW Escrow – Fiddle Creek Dairy (97 Loop Rd): On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors approved returning \$10,400.14 held in escrow to Timothy Sauder (Fiddle Creek Dairy/97 Loop Rd). Motion passed unanimously.

Return of SW Escrow – Jacob B. Zook (45 Stony Hill Rd): On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors approved returning \$3,300.00 held in escrow to Jacob B. Zook (45 Stony Hill Rd).

Zoning Hearing Board: On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors appointed Dayton Kreider as a regular member of the Eden Township Zoning Hearing Board. On a motion by Joseph Rineer and seconded by David Rineer, the Supervisors appointed Tom Spring as an alternate to the Eden Township Zoning Hearing Board. Motions passed unanimously.

Public Participation:

Lawrence Stoltzfus (1281 May Post Office Rd) inquired whether the Township could use the help of a volunteer for community service. The road crew may need help trimming trees.

Tom Spring (217 Stony Hill Rd) asked for an update on Loop Rd. No update was received from the Solicitor, but the Township was awarded a Low Volume Road Grant for stormwater improvements on Loop Rd.

Dayton Kreider (933 Dry Wells Rd) brought up the intersection at Dry Wells and Hess Rds – safety is still an issue. Different sign options were discussed.

Summit Hill Amish School House: Children crossing the road is a safety concern. Mark will contact Patrick Wright at LTAP.

Adjournment: A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 7:42 PM.
