## Eden Township Board of Supervisors Minutes of the November 12, 2018 Meeting

<u>Call-to-Order:</u> Supervisor David Rineer called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>Attendance:</u> Supervisors David Rineer, Randy Kylar and Joseph Rineer; Mark Rudy, Gerry Parker and Szilvia Troutman. Also the following members of the public: Matt Vickers, Elam E. Beiler, John B. Beiler, Joe B. Beiler, Lawrence Stoltzfus, Jesse L. Lapp and Bob Work.

## **Public Participation:**

<u>Matt Vickers and Bob Work</u> were in attendance for the signing of the final plan for Quarryville Industrial Properties. On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors approved signing the plans. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Supervisors Meeting Minutes:</u> The minutes of the October 8, 2018 Supervisors meeting were reviewed. David Rineer motioned, Joseph Rineer seconded to approve the minutes; motion carried unanimously.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> The Treasurer's report for October 2018, in the amount of \$403,342.32 (attached), was approved on a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

<u>Payment of Bills:</u> The list of bills to be paid in November 2018, in the amount of \$27,587.58 (attached), was approved on a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

**SEO Report:** The SEO report listed activity of \$100.00 for the month of October 2018.

Tax Collector's Report: The Tax Collector's report listed activity of \$1,240.95 for the month of October 2018.

**Zoning Officer's Report:** The Zoning Officer's report listed activity in the amount of \$8,358.00 for the month of October 2018.

In agreement with the Eden Township Planning Commission, the Supervisors had the following comments regarding the two zoning hearings scheduled for November 19<sup>th</sup>:

- Beiler/Esh (139/147 Bushong Rd) No objections, but recommend permanently relinquishing any further subdivision rights.
- Benuel K. King (60 Stone Rd) Recommend denial of both requests for variance due to stormwater concerns (overage of impervious lot coverage) and the non-compliant distance of the existing barn from the property line.

Szilvi will write a letter with the above comments to the Zoning Hearing Board.

Road Master's Report: The Road Master's report of activity in October 2018 was reviewed.

**Emergency Management:** No report.

Southern Lancaster County Inter-Municipal Council: No report.

## **Old Business:**

<u>Equipment Co-Op Update:</u> A new account will have to be opened for the roller co-op with BB&T. Eden Township should be added to the signature card for the belt loader co-op account held by Paradise Twp.

<u>Electricity Supplier Contract Renewal:</u> Since the rate discussed at the October meeting was no longer available, Szilvi signed up with Indra Energy at \$.069 for 24 months.

<u>Health Insurance Renewal:</u> It was decided at the October budget meeting to renew the PPO 2000 plan with Capital Blue.

<u>Hess Rd & Dry Wells Rd Intersection Update:</u> Mark installed the two stop bars as discussed at the previous meeting.

## **New Business:**

<u>Return of SW Escrow (Custom Home Group/Eden Farms Lot 9):</u> On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors approved returning the stormwater escrow (\$5,400) held for Eden Farms Lot 9 to Custom Home Group. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Bowery Run Stream Restoration Project by US Fish & Wildlife Service- Request for Twp Comment:</u> A letter will be sent to DEP requesting them to coordinate the stream restoration project with the Township's plans to replace Cherry Hill Rd Bridge in November 2019.

<u>Joan Ross/362 Camargo Road – Safety Concern:</u> A letter will be sent to PennDot requesting additional signage or other measures to improve safety at the location.

**Public Participation:** None.

<u>Adjournment:</u> A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.
